 - **Associate Membership** is open to those individuals with an appropriate science degree and less than 4 years experience of Forensic Toxicology or a Professional Member who is no longer a practicing forensic toxicologist but is still active in the field of forensic toxicology.
 - **Affiliate Membership** is open to those individuals who are professionally linked to the field of forensic toxicology or a postgraduate student enrolled on a forensic toxicology programme.
